- Looking for opportunities to learn life and leadership skills

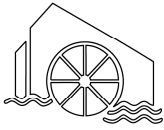
### Commitment:

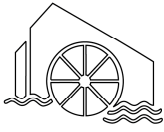

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **What's the Spark Cart?**

The Spark Cart is a mobile activity cart that moves throughout Hagley's property. We do hands-on activities for visitors on this cart, to teach them about innovation at Hagley.

Fun fact: the Spark Cart actually was an ice cream cart we had retrofitted for this purpose!

### **What kind of activities are they?**

The Spark Cart activities focus on different innovative ideas at Hagley. For example, one activity focuses on pulleys and the different ways they can be used. Another focuses on biomimicry, or the idea that human invention is inspired by the natural world (like the connection between woodpecker skulls and bike helmets).

### **What would I do, as a volunteer?**

Each volunteer shift you work with one partner volunteer and an adult mentor. You pick out an activity, set it up, and then present it to visitors as they stop by. Don't worry- we train you on how to do all of this!

### **What kind of training will I get?**

Lots of training! On our first meeting day, we go through all the basics- you get to know the other volunteers and mentors, try out all the cart activities, and learn some basic ideas about interacting with visitors. Then, at each volunteer shift your mentor will help you remember these ideas and give additional pointers. They're always nearby to help you out!

### **What are Build our Skills workshops?**

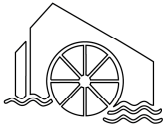
Build our Skills workshops are opportunities for all of us to get together again to learn valuable life skills that will help us with our SparkCart demonstrations and in the future. These are skills like communication, public speaking, organization, time management, teamwork, creativity, and self-confidence. All Build our Skills workshops end with a social time with food and drinks.
