

# Fireworks at Hagley – Accessible Parking FAQs

Accessibility Information for Guests Attending Fireworks at Hagley, 2026

**Q: Where is Accessible Parking and how close is it to all the things I can see and do at Fireworks at Hagley?**

A: The Accessible Parking area is located in the first section of the main parking field that is free of steep inclines, tree roots, and other obstructions. Upon arrival, follow signs and directions from parking staff to access this area.

It has multiple access points to the central location for guest amenities at the event. Directly across from this parking area, guests can find the Hagley Information booth, restrooms (including accessible restrooms), food trucks, the Hagley Store booth, the raffle and silent auction tent, medical services, and more. These amenities are available from 5 p.m. to 8:30 p.m., except for restrooms and medical services, which are available until the end of the evening.

Adjacent to these amenities is the Kid Central entertainment area for younger guests. Kid Central is open from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. and features a variety of activities facilitated by Hagley staff and volunteers.

The entrance/exit to the fireworks viewing area is located approximately 250 feet from the closest accessible parking space and approximately 650 feet from the farthest. The Fireworks show begins at 9:20 p.m. and concludes around 9:50 p.m.



**Q: How many Accessible Parking spaces are there?**

A: Hagley reserves approximately 10% of the parking field for Accessible Parking for Fireworks at Hagley, providing space for 80 vehicles. Due to high demand for accessible parking at Fireworks, we exceed the ADA requirement of 2% (16 vehicles) to better accommodate our guests.

**Q: Do I need to make special arrangements in advance for Accessible Parking?**

A: You do not! Simply ensure your accessible/disabled parking plates or hangtags are visible, and the parking crew will direct you to the next available Accessible Parking space.

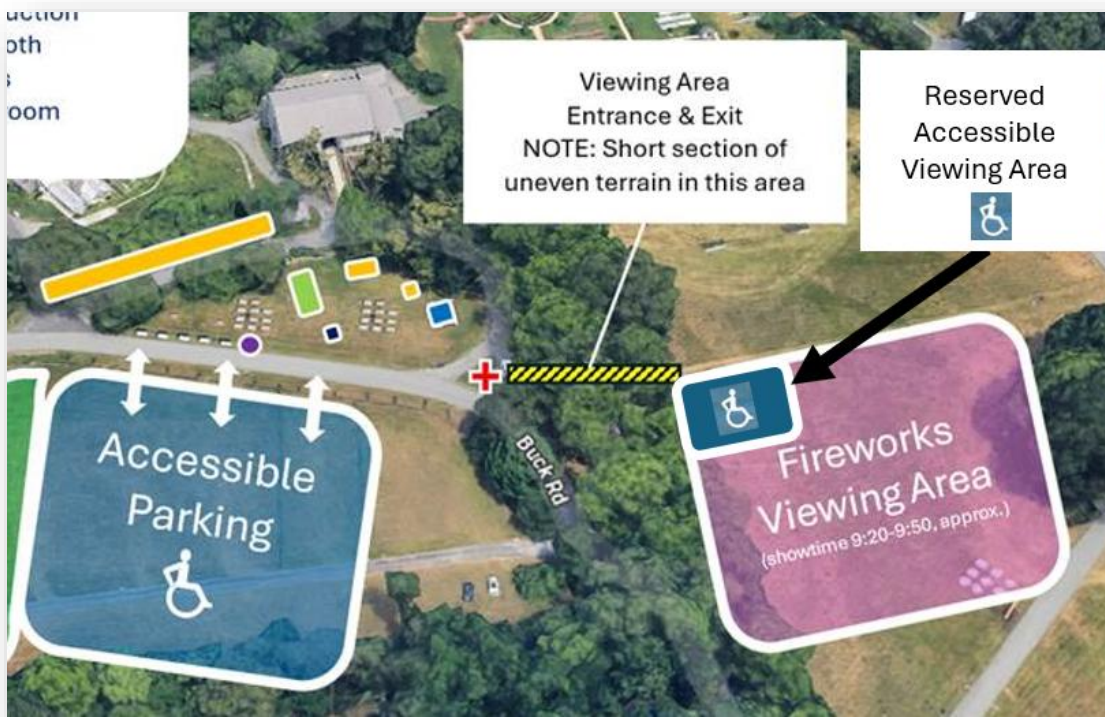
However, if you will be arriving in a vehicle with a lift, please contact [Membership@Hagley.org](mailto:Membership@Hagley.org) at least two weeks before the night of Fireworks you plan to attend. A limited number of spaces (8) are reserved for guests using vehicles with lifts. Like other Accessible Parking, this exceeds ADA requirements in order to provide the easiest access for as many guests as our historic site allows.

**Q: Where is the entrance/exit of the viewing area for the Fireworks show?**

A: To prevent guests and vehicles from traveling on the same roadways during dusk and after the show, when lighting levels are low, there is only one entrance/exit from the parking field to the viewing area.

The entrance/exit of the fireworks viewing area is through a row of historic trees between the main road and the viewing field. The distance is approximately 100 feet and has some uneven terrain.

Just beyond the entrance/exit, a large space at the front of the viewing area is reserved for guests with disabilities and members of their parties.



**Q: When I've attended Fireworks in the past, it looked like Premium Parking was *before* Accessible Parking. Why is that?**

A: During your Fireworks at Hagley experience, you may see a Premium Parking area (reserved parking with an additional fee) near the Accessible Parking area (parking with no additional fee). Premium Parking is indicated in the light orange area on the map below.

The pedestrian entrances/exits for Premium Parking have tree roots and inclines that make this space inaccessible and inappropriate for use as Accessible Parking. Those locations are indicated in the dark orange area on the map below.

Accessible parking is located in the first section of the parking field that is free of steep inclines, tree roots, and other obstructions, and is also the closest area to key guest amenities.



**Q: Is there a drop-off or loading zone?**

A: No. Due to the physical layout of Hagley's historic property, our roadways are not wide enough to provide a safe, accessible drop-off or a loading zone for Fireworks at Hagley.

For guests bringing chairs, blankets, food and beverages, or other items to the event, we strongly encourage bringing wagons, rolling carts, coolers with wheels, and other small devices for transporting your Fireworks at Hagley viewing setup.

**Q: Are there golf carts or other vehicle services to get to a location in the fireworks viewing area?**

A: No. For the safety of all our guests, vehicles are not permitted in the fireworks viewing area, including Hagley vehicles, except in emergency situations. However, limited golf cart transportation is available for guests with disabilities along the road adjacent to the Accessible Parking area to the entrance/exit of the fireworks viewing area prior to the show.
