



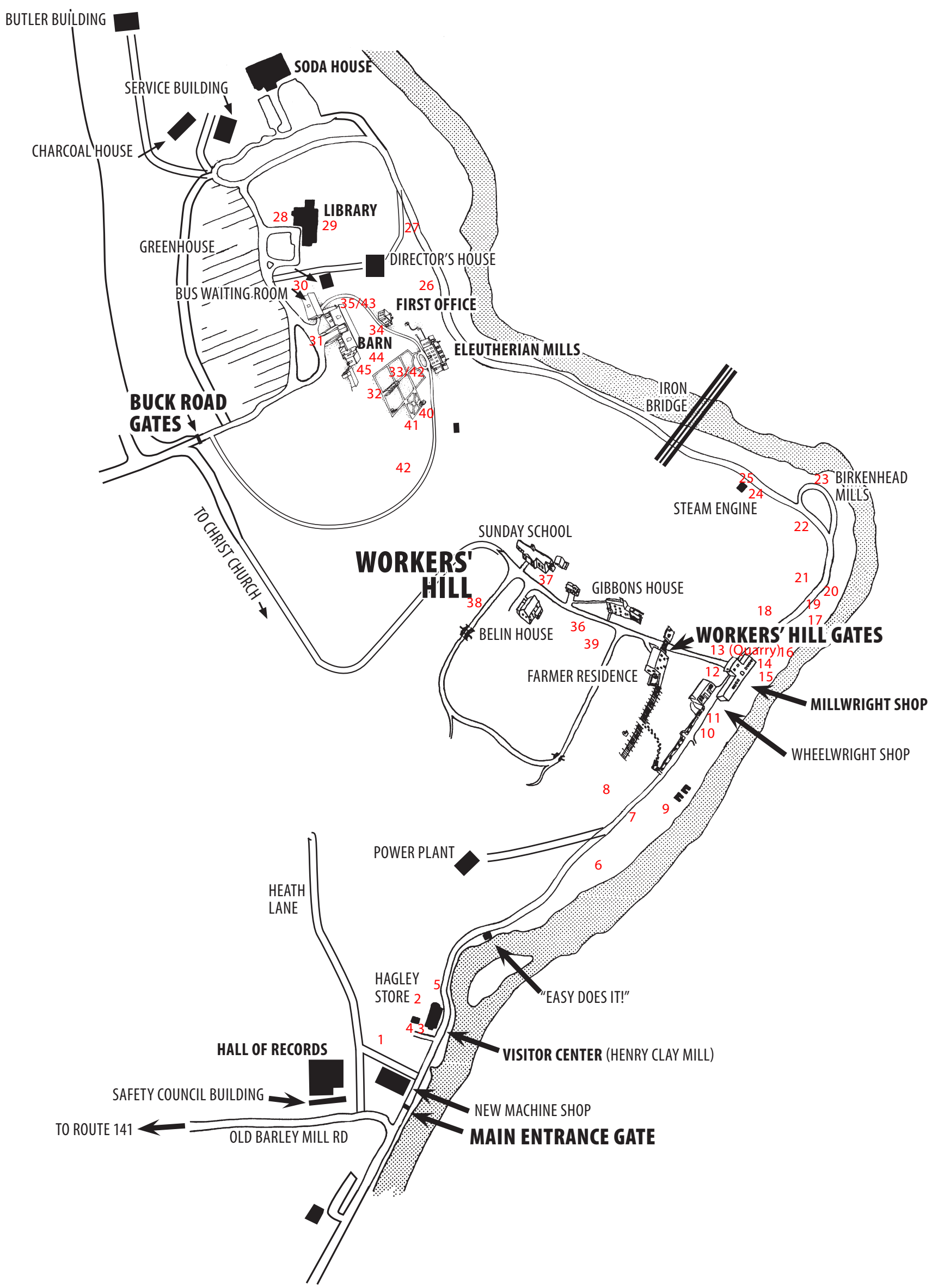
Hagley Museum and Library Tribute Bench Availability

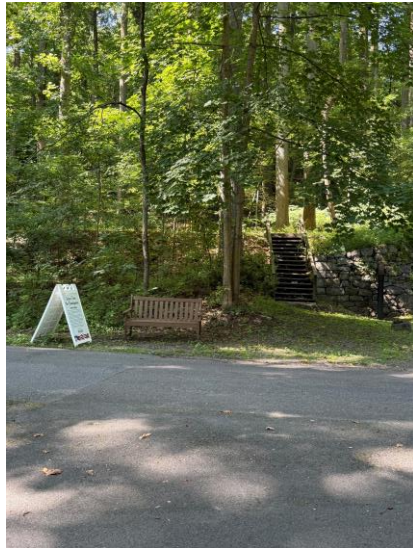

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Hagley Commemorative Bench Gift Agreement

The required donation threshold to commemorate a bench is \$3,000 to cover purchase of teak bench and maintenance costs over the lifetime of the agreement. Hagley will dedicate a new bench furnished with a protective coating; natural weathering will nonetheless occur and will over time alter the bench's patina. This is considered normal. Terms of recognition and upkeep obligations (structural repairs, power-washing as needed) are for the lifetime of the bench or 10 years from installation date, whichever occurs first. Hagley will replace or repair the bench within the term limit in the event of natural disaster or other unanticipated damage to the bench, necessitating such repairs or replacement. After the term limit for recognition is reached, Hagley has the prerogative to assess the bench's useful life and retire or revive the bench. Hagley may invite donor(s) to consider renewing their contribution to continue the terms of recognition and support upkeep costs.
