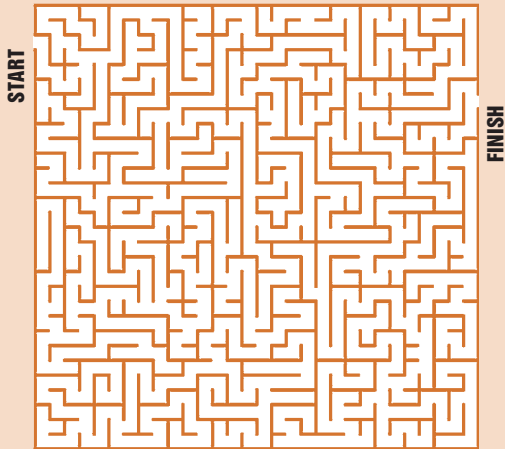


A-maze-ing!



Can you find your way through the maze? Start on the left side of the maze and see if you can find your way out on the right side. Good luck!

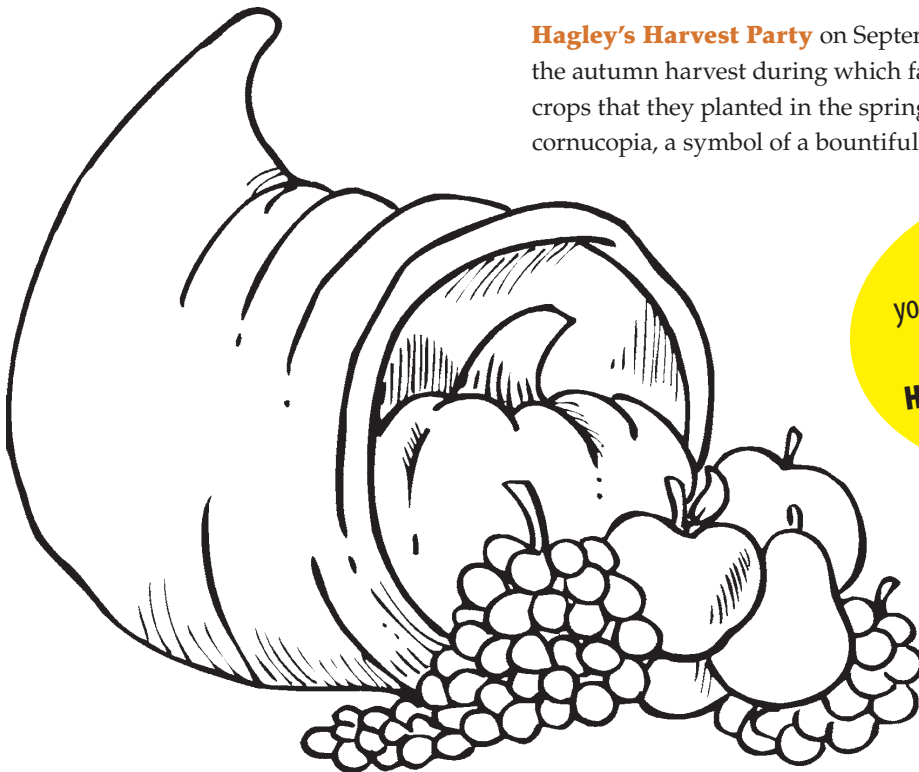

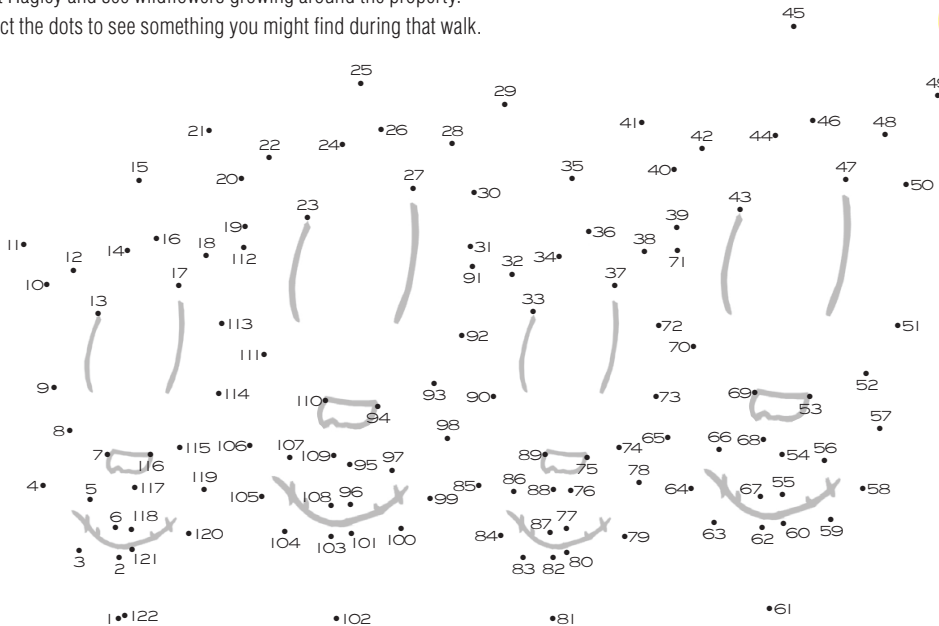

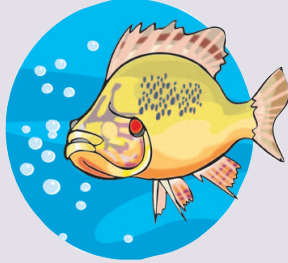

FISHY BUSINESS

At **Hagley's Creek Kids: Fathers and Sons** on June 21 you can fish in the Brandywine. Can you put the following steps for fishing into their proper order?

- A Wait until you see your bobbin sink, or you feel a tug on the line.
- B Now that your bamboo pole is ready and your hook is baited, find a good spot along the Brandywine.
- C Pull back quickly on the bamboo pole to "set" the hook. You've caught a fish!
- D Get your bamboo pole ready—make sure the bobbin and hook are tied on properly.
- E Use your bamboo pole to cast your hook into the water.
- F Bring in the line to take a look at your fish.
- G Put bait onto the hook.

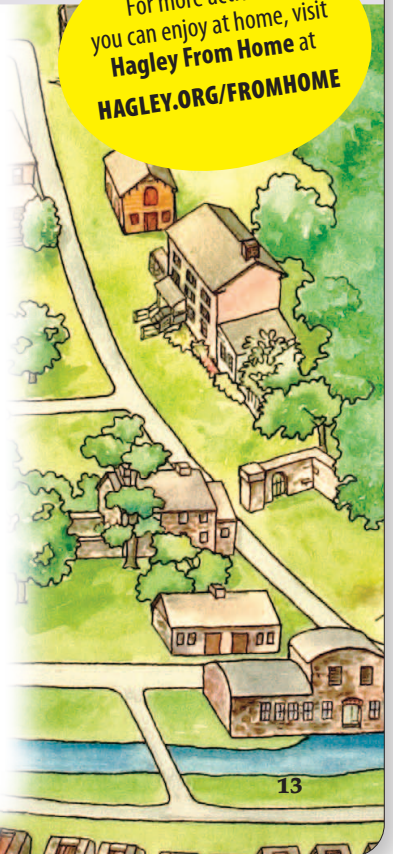

WHO'S ON THE DOLLAR?

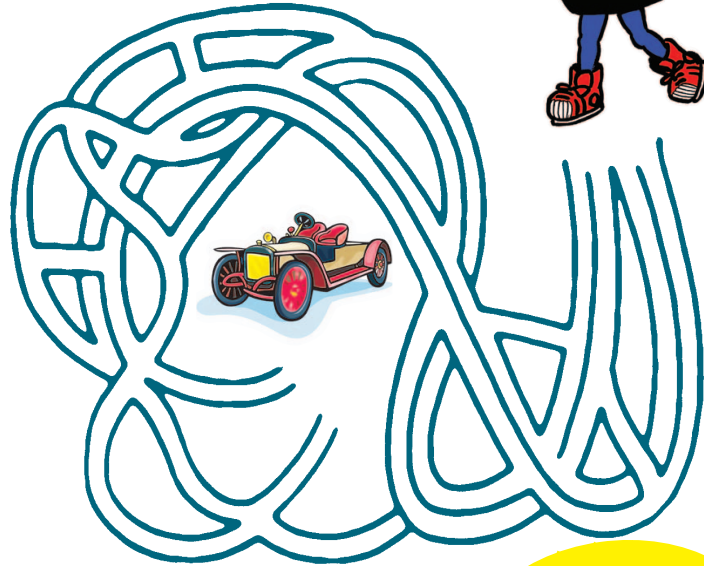
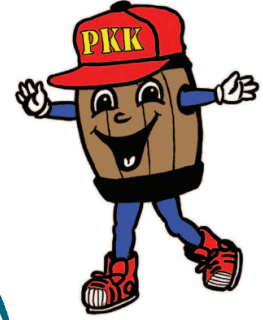
During Thursdays in July and August, you can enjoy one dollar admission to Hagley. Members can always visit the museum for free.

Can you match the people with the correct denomination of dollar bill on which they appear?

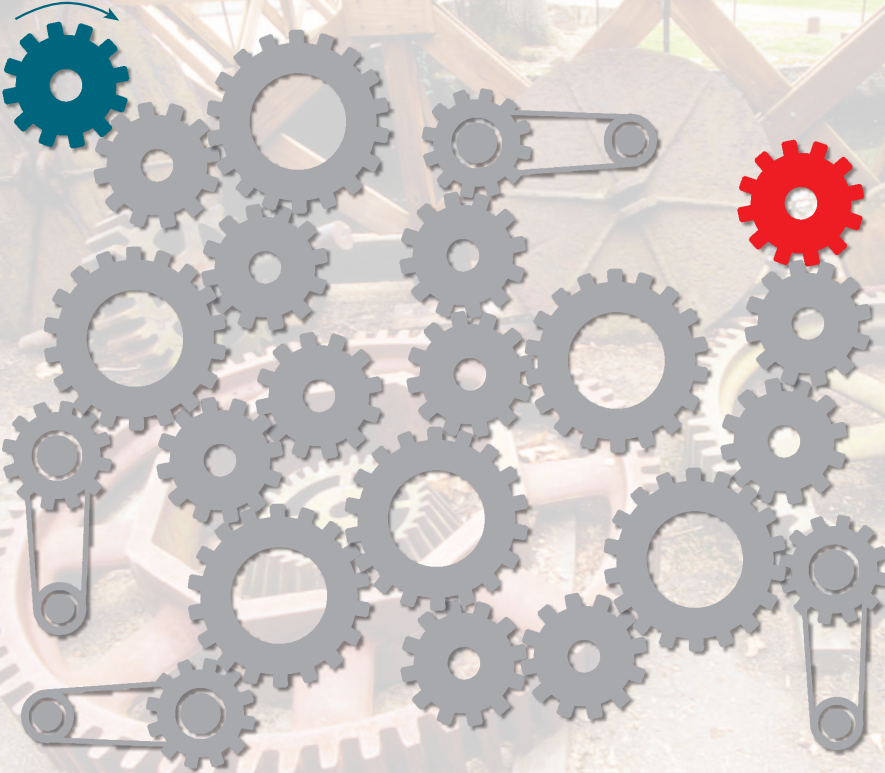
